

MAN OF 89 SUES ATTORNEY

Accounting for \$40,000 Wanted
From Arthur P. Tifft.

George L. Colwell, a white-haired man of 89 years, appeared before Circuit Judge Davis yesterday, pleading that Arthur P. Tifft, an attorney whom he had intrusted with more than \$40,000, be made to account for more than \$25,000 he declared was not reported upon by the lawyer. After hearing the evidence in the morning Judge Davis continued the case until after the record could be expeted.

The attorney admits holding \$25,703 worth of securities, but asserts this was because of a \$324 lien for services yet unpaid. He invites an accounting. Since the filing of the suit he has turned over the records to the plaintiff.
