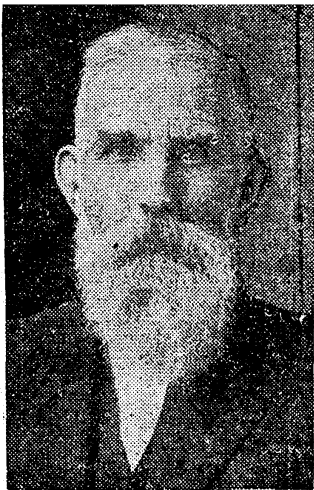


**PIONEER PACIFIC LUMBER-  
MAN DIES AT AGE OF 90.**

George L. Colwell, pioneer lumberman, born in New York in 1827, died Friday at the home of his daughter, Mrs. M. L. Gram, 401 Twelfth street, after a lingering illness. The funeral will be held from the Finley chapel Monday, June 18, at 2:30 P. M.

Mr. Colwell was for many years prior to his retirement one of the best-known figures in the lumbering business of Washington and Oregon. He had extensive interests at Ilwaco, Wash., at the mouth of the Columbia.

Mr. Colwell was a Mason since 1852. Besides his daughter, he is survived by two grandchildren, Mrs. F. H. Morris and Mrs. W. L. Kirkpatrick, and two great-grandchildren, all of Pomona, Cal.
